

This rider is provided to assist you in hosting Kent Bottenfield. We send this to you in order to answer some of the common questions we receive from concert hosts. If you need any further clarification or more information, we invite you to call our office and we will be happy to assist you.

Sound Requirements for church venues

Kent is happy to use the sound system you have in place for your sanctuary. There are only a few things he would like you to provide if they are not already in place.

1. 2 full size monitors (no hot spots please). One for an area at the front of the stage and one for the piano/ keyboard area. 2 full size monitors at the front of the stage would be nice but not required.
2. 1 wireless handheld microphone or 2 wired handheld microphones. If using wired please make one available at the front of the stage and one available at the piano/keyboard using a boom stand.
3. 1 CD player (not portable) to run the tracks that Kent will be bringing with him.

Products

Please provide one 6 or 8 foot table in an accessible lobby adjacent to the sanctuary or auditorium Kent will be singing in.

Taping

Kent would like you to feel free to record (audio and video) any part of the performance you wish. He only asks that it not be duplicated or sold and that it be used for purposes inside of the church only. All forms of photography are acceptable.

Hotel

If hotel accommodations are required in the performance contract please make the reservations for late arrival, late departure. Some hotels offer a “day rate” that would be beneficial.

It would be helpful if the hotel you select is in close proximity (within walking distance) to local restaurants and shopping if possible.

Please avoid bed & breakfast accommodations unless no other suitable location is available.

Transportation

If Kent is flying in for your event it would be helpful to have someone meet him at the airport and take him to and from all of the events that have been planned and agreed to ahead of time.

If someone is available to drive Kent to and from all events he requires that the individual be a licensed driver and that there be no unaccompanied females. There must always be at least one male present during these times. If a driver is not available please let us know no later than 2 days in advance so Kent can make other arrangements.

Due to Kent's heavy schedule and health situation it is important that extra events that are not planned and agreed to ahead of time not be added to the itinerary. Kent is happy to do what it takes to make your event a success but we schedule carefully ahead of time so he can get his rest and stay on top of his condition. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Please be assured that Kent is looking forward to your event and we are here to do anything that we can to assist in making this a great event for everyone involved. Please don't hesitate to call for any reason.
